Legislative Initiatives 2024

JLC1: Property Tax Exemption for Surviving Spouses of Service Members who died in the line of duty. Passed and signed by the Governor. Constitutional amendment that requires a referendum this fall.

JLC2: Veterans Service Protection Act to protect veterans against prohibited practices. Passed and approved by the Governor.

JLC3: National Guard Tuition Assistance Program. Continued in Senate Finance until 2025.

JLC4: Active Duty status for National Guard members injured in the line of duty. Passed and signed by the governor.
