Virginia Offers Free Tax Filing Online:

The Virginia Free File program offers taxpayers simple and free options for filing both state and federal tax returns.

Approximately 70% of all Virginia taxpayers are eligible to use the brand-name tax software products offered through Free File to prepare and electronically file their federal *and* state income tax returns online for **FREE**. If your income is less than \$50,000 then you are probably eligible. To see if you are eligible, go to <u>www.tax.virginia.gov</u>

Lost Pet Report/Lost & Found

Believe it or not we reunited 21 dogs with their families since Thanksgiving weekend. Keep putting identification on your pets and sign up for the neighborhood Email notification list. Between these two FREE programs we have been very successful in locating pet owners.

Our Real Estate Market...

Just a reminder that if you made an energy efficient upgrade to your home in 2013, you may be eligible for a tax credit. The credit, which had expired, has been reinstituted for qualifying improvements made before January 1, 2014. Eligible upgrades include installing a furnace or hot water heater, replacing windows, doors, or skylights; replacing a roof or adding insulation to walls and attics. Upgrades must meet specific energy efficiency standards. Be sure to ask your tax advisor for details.
