General Membership Meeting
March 20, 2014

We had 28 people at the meeting.

Donna Price called the meeting to order, and asked for a motion to approve the Minutes from the January meeting. A motion was made and the members voted to accept the Minutes.

Carol Moore gave the Treasurer's Report, as follows:

- Checking account - \$4,602.23
- Money Market account - \$15,753.53
- Total - \$20,355.76

As of today, we have 185 paid members in the Civic League. In addition, we have received \$480 in donations.

Following a motion to approve, the vote was taken and the Treasurer's Report was accepted.

Tim Roy asked when he should start cutting the grass. Donna told him that we had budgeted grass cutting for five months, and he should begin in May. The City will take care of cutting back the liriopse.

Mike Moore has done light repairs at the flagpole, so everything should be fine in regard to the flag.

We have a volunteer to take care of Block Security in the townhomes. Ms. Chaney (sp.?) will also take care of newsletter delivery there.

Cheryl Douglas will take care of newsletter delivery on St. Alban Street. Jim Price volunteered to be a newsletter deliverer helper.

Jim Price reported that a couple of neighbors on Sheffield Court have had cars broken into—the car doors had been left unlocked. Everyone should be careful to lock their vehicles. There was no report from the Welcoming Committee.
