

Pembroke Meadows Civic League  
General Membership Meeting  
May 15, 2014

Donna Price called the meeting to order, and asked for a motion to approve the Minutes from the April meeting. A motion was made and the members voted to accept the Minutes. Probably because there was no e-mail reminder about the meeting, attendance tonight was very sparse.

We had some teen visitors who were completing a civic project for school. Donna told them the names of the civic league officers. She told them that Clif Furedy posts the meeting minutes to the web and sends an e-mail saying that the minutes have been posted.

Carol Moore gave the Treasurer's Report, as follows:

- Checking account - \$1,955.85
- Money Market account - \$12,396.74
- Total - \$14,352.59
- We purchased picnic tables and loungers for the pool. This purchase came to about \$8,000.
- Income from the cell tower has increased slightly.
  - Donna explained to the students about the cell phone tower. The income allows us to be very generous to the pool. We have had the cell tower for about 6 years. In addition to paying for improvements to the pool, money from the tower paid for a new gazebo. It also allows us to pay someone to cut the grass on the median, May through September.

Newsletter:

- The newsletter should be on our doors this weekend. For the students' benefit, Donna explained that we put out a newsletter about nine times a year, January through May and then a mid-summer edition.

Garden Club Report:

- Carol reported that work has been done at the pool, and we are awaiting the delivery of mulch.

Clif asked if anybody saw a message from Jim Hall about the newsletter being available. No one saw it.

Donna told the students we have a Pet Lost and Found, and it has been very effective. Jerry Richter who manages that also has a box turtle habitat in her backyard.

Lakes and Waterways:

- Saturday, June 7 from 9 to 12 is Clean the Bay Day. Our area consists only of lakes and waterways adjacent to our neighborhood. Jeff Brown is now the captain for our area. The newsletter will show the various area coordinators.
- Volunteers cleared out the Lake Meadows drain.
- If you are unable to help on June 7, you may get an orange bag and do it early in the week.
- There has been a report of poison ivy along the dam pathway.

National Night Out:

- Donna has sent an invitation to the Third Precinct. She is also going to invite the Fire Department clown.

Mike Moore needs some input about future speakers for our meetings. Jim Willenbrink suggested someone to talk about the new flood zones.

There being no additional business, Donna adjourned the meeting at 7:38 p.m.
