She presented very helpful information on a Financial Wellness Program that is available through the Department of Human Services. It is a ten-month free program to help citizens learn different ways to save and improve their money management skills with incentives such as matched savings. The neighboring cities of Norfolk, Chesapeake and Portsmouth are now also involved. Business and individual donations are used for funding and volunteers are needed. Those interested in helping would be provided free training. Ms. Wyche gave out pamphlets with additional information and contact numbers.
