New Business –

Pool News – The pool is closed for the year. They had 180 members this past season. The Pool Board voted in a new Treasurer and Vice President. There is pool money set aside for the hole for the big umbrella. The umbrella came in late, so it was never installed. A hole 6 feet deep by 3 feet in diameter needs to be dug. We will wait and get bids.

Ferry Plantation House Wine, Beer and Cheese Event –

This will be held on Thursday, November 21. We will have a brief meeting to hold the Board member elections at this time.

They first asked about the gazebo area, but this would not be good due to safety concerns. Other possible locations for their sale could be the park or the Food Lion parking lot. It was suggested that they could come and speak at a Civic League meeting.

Old Business –

A special meeting was held at the National Night Out. A decision was made to plant a tree and have a bench put up as well as a donation to Jason. Carol asked if the bench could replace one of the old ones that are positioned with a view of the water. They said they would get back with us regarding this. We are hoping to have this come back by the Halloween Walk so we could have a dedication.
