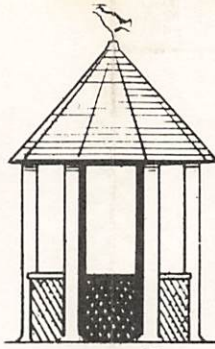

 a final get-together.

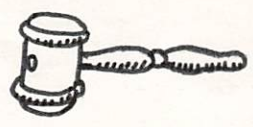
On June 14th, the City of Va. Beach

ADC Redetermination Aide (assist eligibility workers in the determination of eligibility for financial assistance. PLEASE CALL!

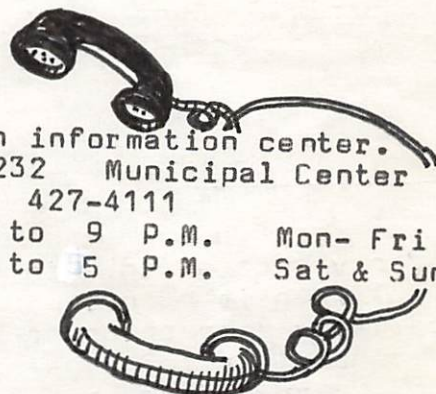
