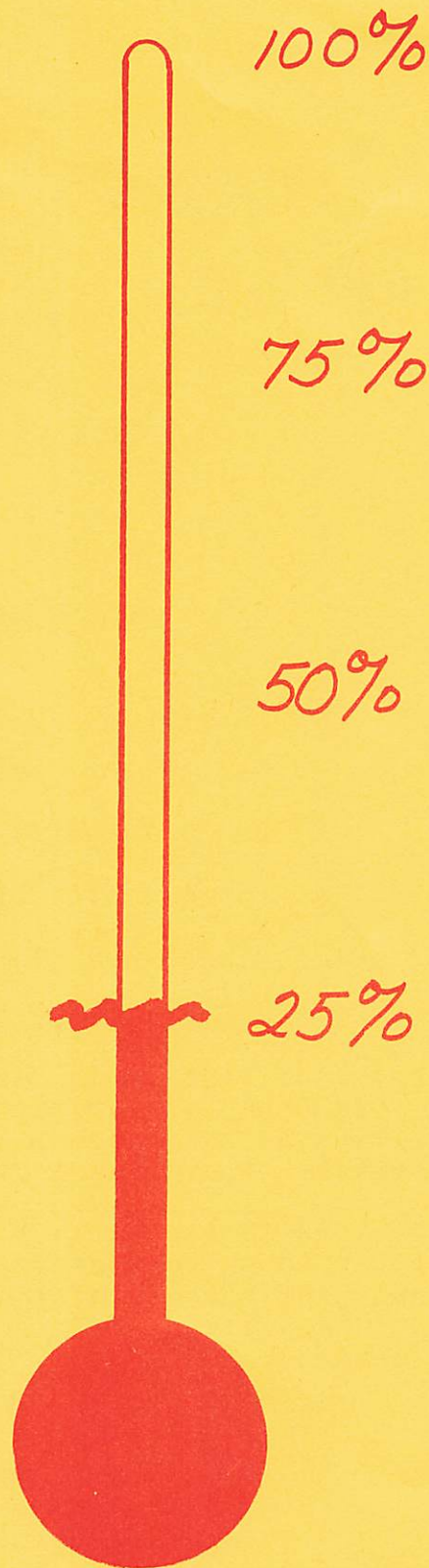
CIVIC LEAGUE MEMBERSHIP

PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS

Community homeowners who have received their 1978-79 property assessments have noted an increase this year. According to the Ledger-Star (24 Feb. 78), Virginia Beach real estate owners experienced an average 7.7 percent tax increase this year.

Real estate assessments are based on sales of similar pieces of property within a subdivision.

Usually, there is about one year lag time between the sales and the new assessment. Real estate assessments are also based on 100% of the fair market value.

The City of Virginia Beach experienced a healthy growth rate last year. Did our community keep abreast of the rest of the City? Will we keep abreast this year? Remember, property value is based on both individual appearance and the overall community appearance and reputation. LET'S MAKE OUR COMMUNITY THE BEST IN THE CITY.

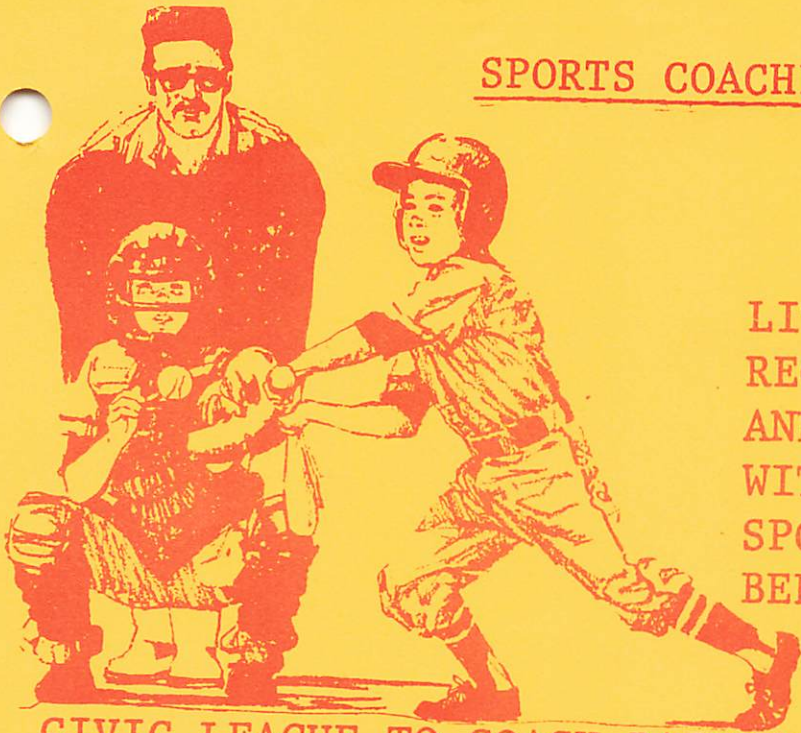
