OLD DONATION PARKWAY:

At the Public Hearing held January 18th. before the Virginia Beach Planning Commission, every Civic League of communities along the proposed route of Old Donation Parkway spoke in FAVOR of DELETING it from the Master Street and Highway Plan. The only person who spoke in favor of keeping it alive was Robert Scott, the city's Director of Planning. The vote on the motion to recommend it to be deleted FAILED to pass. This means that the Planning Commission will recommend to City Council that the right of way for the Old Donation Parkway be kept on the Master Plan.

Mr. Scott stated there are No Plans to build the parkway in the next ten years however, the right of way is needed to protect the potential traffic needs of the future.

At the urging of the Pembroke Meadows/ Shores representative a motion was PASSED to recommend DELETION of FUNDS currently in the five-year Capital Improvements Program slated for the study and design of the two bridges proposed to span the branches of the Lynnhaven River. Should City Council adopt this recommendation, there would be NO FUNDS allotted for any portion of Old Donation Parkway for at least five years.

A motion will be placed before City Council sometime in February to DELETE the parkway from the Master Street and Highway Plan.

Parkway cont;

At this writing it appears there are enough Council members in favor of DELETING the parkway to carry the motion. BUT THEY MUST HEAR FROM US.

(elective) grade students are educated in environmental awareness and trained teachers provide workshops to community groups. This I.C.E. program is a positive step in helping Virginia Beach citizens to become objective about present and future environmental problems in their city, many of which are unique because of the city's geography.

Mrs. Barbara Allison, I.C.E. project coordinator for the school system, and Miss Kity Watts, a 7th. grade teacher of science at Pembroke Meadows, will present the program. Please contact any member of the board if you would like to assist the Civic League as editor or typist- or both.

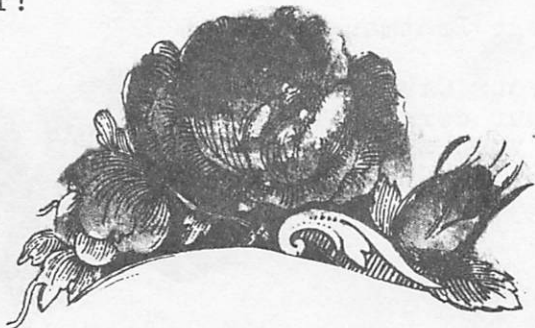
LEND A HAND IN YOUR COMMUNITY:

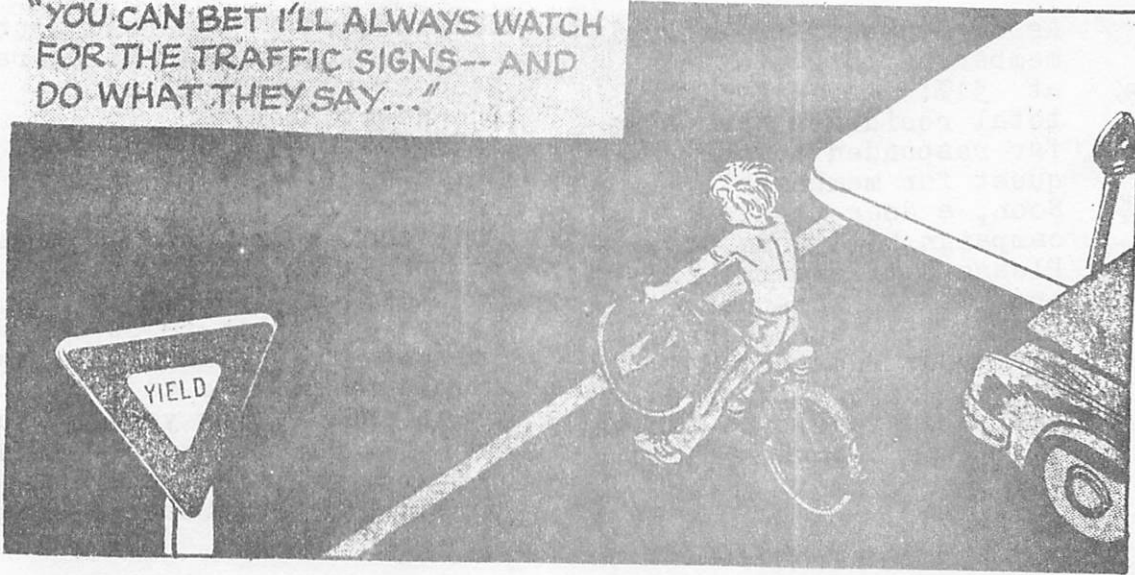
To qualify for the midget group you must be 10 on or before May 15th.

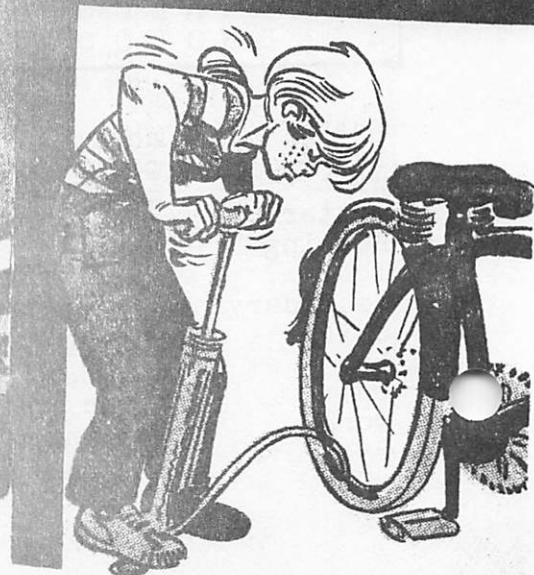
