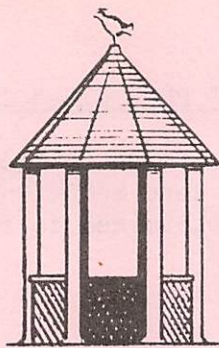

RECOMMENDATION: The major equipment fixed asset book value of \$15,000.00 for the original purchase cost of pumps, gas chlorination equipment, etc., is adequate. In view of replacement costs and inflation, however, it is felt that the current insured value of \$9,000.00 for this equipment is inadequate. It is therefore recommended that the board review this aspect of insurance coverage with a view toward increasing the coverage to an adequate replacement cost, less depreciation.
