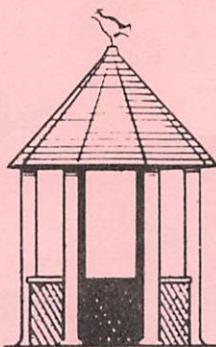

Although many of these activities are open to non-members at a modest increase in price, it is only through the participation of the active membership that these programs can be conducted.

THE \$2.00 GUEST FEE

As in the past Recreation Center members are encouraged to invite guests to share in the activities at our pool. Unfortunately abuses of the guest privilege as a means to circumvent the payment of annual dues has been a problem. In this regard the following statement of policy is published.

1. Residents of Pembroke Meadows, Pembroke Shores, and Hudgins-Shores who are not active members of the Recreation Center are NOT afforded the privilege of entry to the facilities as a guest except as specifically authorized by the Recreation Committee for certain organized activities.

2. Persons other than those excluded above when sponsored and accompanied by an active member may utilize the facilities upon payment of a guest fee of \$2.00 per person per day.

3. Persons residing outside the Tidewater area who are legitimate overnight houseguests of an active member will be admitted to the facilities free of charge if such arrangements are made in advance with the Pool Manager. Temporary guest passes will be issued.

\$2.00 FEE CON'T

The guest fee has been increased for the 1980 season after judicious consideration of the average daily cost of an outside membership to which the guest privilege is directed. It is further recognized that this action will place additional burden on some families; however, the intent is to stimulate interest in new memberships upon which the operation of the Recreation Center is founded.

POOL CLEAN-UP MONTH

May is Pool Clean-Up Month. After almost total abandonment since last September, there is much work to be done in preparation of opening day, 24 May. The Recreation Center survives by the work of community volunteers, and 1980 is no exception. Working parties are scheduled for every weekend this month and some weekdays and early evenings. VA. BEACH SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM

The City of Virginia Beach Department of Mental Health Comprehensive Substance Abuse Program has relocated its offices to Pembroke Six. This agency provides outpatient counseling and referral services for alcohol and drug related problems for Virginia Beach residents of any age.

The Counseling and Outreach Center (Formerly "Outreach" at the beach) provides the following services;

Trained and experienced drug counselors to serve area residents;

Initial client contact point for the entire CSAP Program;

Substance-related screening, evaluation, treatment and referral;

Medical evaluation for appropriate clients;

Group education;

Individual, family and group counseling;

Referrals to other agencies within or outside Virginia Beach, including detoxification units and residential treatment facilities; and

Counselors who will speak to residents on the telephone for initial contact.

Virginia Beach residents who have problems or think they or a friend or relative may have a substance abuse problem should contact the CSAP. The Administrative Office can be reached by calling 497-4829 and the Counseling and Outreach Center's number is 499-5401.
