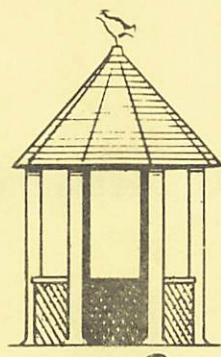

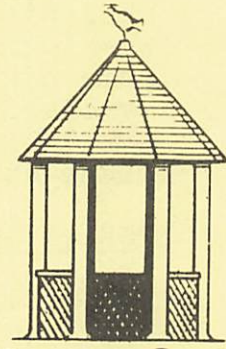
## GARDEN CLUB
