# ylaws Update Nearing Completion

The Civic League Bylaws were last distributed with the 1982 Directory (yellow cover) and some amendments were voted in March 1989 and May 1989.

At the October 19th Civic League Meeting those changes and some new ones will be presented to the mambership. This article and the discussions at the October meeting constitute the notice to our members about the changes.

The primary revisions are changing the 3rd V.P. title to Director of Recreation Center and making the necessary changes in reference throughout. In article XV, (which details the Recreation Center operations), we updated election procedures, terms of office of the Recreation Center Committee as well as the fiscal year for the Recreation Center.

There will be several copies of the prepared new bylaws with highlighted changes available at the October Civic League meeting. We would like to vote on these in November so we can proceed with publishing them in an update to our 1988 Civic League Directory (blue cover).


