

Lake Meadows Dam Improvements

As was discussed at recent Civic League meetings, and responsive to our Civic League inquires, the city (Public Works Dept.) has re-affirmed by letter that the following improvements to the Lake Meadows dam area are still planned:

"1. Dam needs to be resurfaced in accordance with construction plans approved December 2, 1987addressing the bikeway/pedestrian path. This includes a 1 inch overlay of lituminous concrete type S-5. A 10 feet width has been established with a 4 inch solid white stripe 4 feet from the southern edge of the pavement.

2. A 280 feet two rail, split rail fence must be installed on both sides of the dam....located 1 foot from the southern edge of the pavement and 3 feet from the northen edge of the pavement, the entire length of the

dam."

Plans also "require the developer to install three (3) overhead lights to the three existing utility poles located along the dam." (The Civic League has expressed a preference for colonial—style park lanterns for the pathway, but for various reasons the lanterns might not be approved). The above improvements must be accomplished by the developer of Old Donation Farms prior to the city's acceptance and certification of the subdivisions completion






