PEMBROKE MEADOWS POOL OPENS MAY 28

The 1994 swim season starts in Pembroke Meadows with the Memorial Day weekend festivities.

Sat. and Sun., May 28 - 29 the pool is open to non-members at \$3 per person. (Guest fees may be applied to memberships purchased that weekend!)

Mon, May 30, Memorial Day is Members Only, with special activities planned.

When Memorial Day weekend is past, there is still lots of fun to come at the pool this summer:

*Family Nights -- 2 or 3 Sundays per month, starting June 26, the pool hours are extended to 10 pm and special activities are planned.

*Teen and Pre-teen nights -- there will be special evenings designated for these age groups,

with adult chaperons, to enjoy the pool from 8 to 10 pm. Watch the member board for details.

*Cookouts at lunch or dinner time on weekends.

*Adult Socials -- note: non-members are most welcome! At least once each month, starting Saturday, June 18, the pool becomes a focal point for sharing delicious food and warm camaraderie after regular hours. Private parties can be booked very easily for after pool hours (usually 8 pm.) Just call Pam Cruze to reserve your day -- these are great for all ages!

CIVIC LEAGUE MEMBERSHIP

Membership reported at the last board meeting is 169; of that, 12 are businesses associated with our community, so the actual resident membership is 157. Considering approximately 694 households that are eligible membership units, that results in about a 22 1/2% rate of involvement. Pool membership will increase this percentage somewhat, but considering the high level of activity within our Civic League *on everybody's behalf*, it should be higher right now! Our February, 1993 membership of 182 was the highest recorded membership ever. Pembroke Meadows/ Shores does not "ask for something for nothing."
