




LAKE MEADOWS

MPROVEMENTS: You may have noticed that the planned work on the Lake Meadows dam/pathway is well underway. Our primary concern (after the pathway easement was legally confirmed) has been that the dam had been dangerously weakened by years of erosion and subsurface water intrusion. Did you know that the dam was constructed well over a hundred years ago principally of oyster and clam shells mixed with sand, gravel and dirt? It is part of the history of the Old Ferry Farm, but not built to withstand the huge storm water runoff loads that our area's development of the past 40 years has placed on it. To prevent the danger of catastrophic failure of that dam, the City, at the Civic League's request, has placed a rip-rap wall of attractive blue granite rocks underlain by a strong filter cloth along the lake side of the dam. It has also cleared and placed a larger grate on the lake's drain to facilitate better drainage during storms. The asphalt pathway is now being resurfaced and realigned to the correct easement. The area is getting a general "dress up" and a new fence will be installed. When completed the pathway/dam will not only be substantially stabilized and safer, but also more functional and attractive. Please help to keep it that way!

Elsewhere on the lake, City backhoes are working to clear most of the outfalls of the debris and much which have inhibited drainage and caused unsightly and unhealthy clogging of the inlets and coves. For further information,

BAYSIDE LIBRARY FUTURE-

A GOOD PLAN EMERGES: As

previously reported, the future location and proposed expansion of our Bayside Library and 3rd Precinct Police Station have been open to question. As the plan now stands, the City will seek to acquire up to 200 feet of adjacent land from Sentara Hospital so that a new and expanded library and a new, enlarged police station can both be built at that same general site on Independence Boulevard. This is the exact course of action our Civic League recommended and now endorses. The process of funding the land acquisition and construction will take time. Under this plan there will be no disruption of library or police operations because the current buildings can continue in service until the new buildings are completed. It is a great plan and we certainly hope it


