COMMERCIAL VEHICLE PARKING NOT PERMITTED ON STREETS After considerable discussion at our last Civic League meeting, it was disclosed that the City Zoning Ordinance states specifically that:

"Parking of a commercial vehicle in residential or aprartment districts shall be prohibited, except that one (1) commercial vehicle of one (1) ton or less in carrying capacity and which does not exceed seven (7) feet in height or twenty (20) feet in length may be parked on any lot where there is located a main building by a resident of the premises."

PARK PATH GATE AND BYWAY TO BE INSTALLED Because of repeated illegal removal of the center post which had prevented the dangerous, destructive (and illegal) vehicle traffic into our Lake Meadows Park and path, the City has agreed to the following solution. A swinging gate will be installed at the end of the cul-de-sac and kept locked, thus accessible to park maintenance vehicles and our Civic League. To permit the free flow of pedestrians and bicycles, a five-foot bypass around the gate will be asphalted; construction to begin within two weeks. SOME MAINTENANCE TIPS FOR THE NOVICE Our homes were built with aluminum wiring. Fall is a good time to go around your home and check the receptacles. Run your hand over all receptacles testing for heat. For all receptacles that are subjected to frequent plugging and unplugging (vacuum cleaner, hair dryers, appliances, etc), we should turn off electricity at the box and then check to be sure the connection wires are tight. Aluminum wires tend to become loose. This can be dangerous. Test the breakers for overheating by running your hand down them. If you are not comfortable doing this, call an electrician. ALWAYS remember when adding new lighting fixtures or replacing receptacles to install using proper methods for aluminum wiring.


