

PMPS Civic League Pet Lost and Found

The information that I am about to give you leaves me with a heavy heart. Because of this incident happening maybe it will make our neighborhood more aware of the Pembroke Meadows/Shores Pet Lost and Found.

On Monday morning June 25th at 6 a.m., as I do every morning, I went to pick up my granddaughter one street over. Two dogs were lying in the middle of the street at St. John Court in the townhouses. Thinking it strange and that they could be sleeping, I approached them. One, a Black Lab, alive with choke chain collar and no tags, was loyally guarding a collie type Springier Spaniel with a blue choke collar with no tags, that lay in a pool of

blood and had been dead for hours. The police were called. My concern was that young children would be out playing within the next few hours and the animal control was not open yet.

A call was made to Peggy Caverly to inform her that an officer coming. After returning home, I called everyone with a Black Lab and a Springer Spaniel type on the pet registry. And, yes, I did wake some people up, but I did feel it was necessary. I could not find the owners of the dogs. Peggy and I had to stand and watch as the two dogs were taken away. I do want to thank the neighbors on St. John Court. We borrowed your hoses and connected them all together and used another neighbor's water to wash the street down. Our own hoses would not reach. We are thanking you and you don't even know that it happened.

This happening is making me feel so sad because the owners not only had one dog die, but they do not even know that the other was taken to animal control. The Lab was so faithful to the Spaniel that it stayed by its side throughout the night and because of this has no home to be in. This was a well-kept dog; the Lab's nails had just been trimmed. If anyone knows the family that owns these two dogs, please let them know. If we just had some information in our files or a phone number on the collar, the Lab could have been returned home. This is most disturbing to me.

It appears that the dog was hit in the head by a car. There were no brake marks on the road. Maybe the driver was backing up and did not see the dog in the darkness. Please let this unfortunate accident be a lesson to all pet owners. We maintain the PET LOST AND FOUND SERVICE for you at no cost. Just send your pet's information to Belinda Nash 801 Cathedral Drive, or drop it off. Make sure your pets are not out wandering the streets at all hours. Drivers, please take care and be on the lookout for Man's Best Friend. If you spot a lost pet or lose one, report it to Jim Willenbrink at 497-0700 or to me at 490-2504.
