
LAWN & GROUNDS CARE

Over the years the Garden Club and the Civic League have had an excellent working relationship with our City Landscape Services Division. THE TWO MEDIANS IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD ARE CITY PROPERTY. Because of that fact, we obtain permission from the City before any changes are made. The City TRUSTS us to do some of the maintenance in an appropriate manner. Some of the newer plant species which have been installed in recent years require lower maintenance and actually were hybridized to stay at a certain level in height. However, when this type of plant is sheared rather than pruned, it actually grows instead of staying at its designed height.

If anyone is interested in helping with some of the maintenance and upkeep that we customarily undertake, please feel free to contact appropriate officers of either the Garden Club (Jeanette Willenbrink @ 497-0700) or the Civic League (Clera Hall @ 473-8258). 




