

#### Scam Alerts

Last month we mentioned that *Bubbas Tree Service* had ripped off one of our residents. We have also passed along email alerts of Medicare scammers who are trying to get personal financial information.

Here are FIVE things that will safeguard yourself, your property and your money

- 1. Always, ask for references
- 2. Always, ask to see business license/contractor license, etc.
- <u>NEVER</u> pay money up front. If they insist, get another person or company to do the job
- 4. Check the Better Business Bureau for any complaints, Googling the company/person may turn up some information as well.
- Ask about any other people coming onto your property to do the job, who they are, how many, how long they have worked for the company, etc.

## Please help Keep Our Streets And Waterways Clean

Know your city ordnance: Section 33-13

All owners or occupants of real property shall maintain the sidewalks and curbs and the right-of-way up to the edge of the pavement of any public street abutting such property in a clean and litter-free condition. This is for naturally occurring debris; leaves, twigs & dirt. When debris is deliberately placed in the City right of way Code Enforcement will issue notices of violation.
