



the past 20 years, have met and enjoyed some of our very best friends there and enjoyed watching our boys grow into good swimmers.





FALL GARDENING TIPS

- Mow/mulch fallen leaves with a lawnmower and place them on garden beds for spring time weed control and long term soil enrichment.
- Fall is good time to reduce your lawn coverage by creating new flower or shrub beds. Any reduction in lawn decreases rainwater runoff into our local estuaries.
- Fall is a good time to plant trees and shrubs
 -- Any month that ends in 'er' is a good month to plant
- This recommendation goes for transplanting as well.
- Fall is also a good time to tackle non-native invasives such as English ivy and honeysuckle.
- Use a minimalistic approach to lawn fertilization. Fertilize once a year in the fall

and use phosphorus-free products as the soil in Southeast Virginia is naturally high in phosphorus.
