

Thank you for making the 2013 Halloween Walk a big success. Details inside...









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
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Dear Neighbors:

Our Real Estate Market...

Many clients have asked me lately if they should rent their home rather than sell. Admittedly, rents are increasing at a much higher rate than the sales prices, making the idea of renting your home very appealing. However, there is no one right answer for every scenario.
