



Lost Pet Program Update

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

I have been informed by the elves that Santa had several puppies in his sleigh. If one was left under your tree be sure to register it with our FREE lost pet program.

If you already have a pet please put identification on the collar. Chips are great but most companies require you to pay an annual fee to keep the service. Most folks don't realize this and the chip becomes useless in identifying your pet.

A collar ID with phone # is best, and a nice New Years present for your dog in the event it is ever lost.

PLEASE DO YOUR PET AND YOUR FAMILY A FAVOR BY COMPLETING A FORM AND MAILING IT PROMPTLY. This is a FREE program offered to our community.

Safe Pet Identification

Embroidered collars with the Pets name and your phone number with area code is the safest means of quick identification. These collars can be ordered on line (I like the ones from LUCKYPET.COM) or purchased locally from Care-a-Lot store located on Diamond Springs Road. They cost less than \$20. There are no tags to catch dew claws, nothing to fall off and lose and it can be washed if needed. You can select the color, closer (buckle or clip) and size. It sure makes it easier for your pet to be returned to you.


