
Next Civic League Meeting Pembroke Meadows Elementary School January 21, 2016 @ 7 pm



Crack Pretzels

Clera Hall

2	1 LB bags	Rold Gold Thin or Tiny
		Twist Pretzels
1	bottle	Orville Redenbacher
		Popcorn Oil
2	tsps	garlic salt
1	tsp	dill weed
1	pkg.	Ranch Style Dressing Mix

Mix all ingredients together except pretzels.

Put pretzels in a 2 gal. Ziploc plastic bag. Pour mixture over pretzels.

Seal bag.

Turn to coat and let sit on counter for 24 hours.

Turn bag frequently.

Put pretzels into air tight containers to store. Enjoy.
