

# **Befriend Thy Neighbor**

Some of you knew her, most of you didn't. Her name is Helen Rowley, "Miss Helen" to me. She lived right across the street from me, and we were friends for several years.

I tried to keep an eye out for her daily as she was nearly 87, very independent and a loner. I was her only friend on our street because she was rather hard to know, but I did.

She loved it when I asked her over to sit on the front porch, have a glass of wine and have "girl talk" and laugh. She loved the times I had her in during the Christmas Holidays, again for a glass of wine, girl talk and laughs in front of my Christmas tree.

She loved the Civic League's "Wine and Cheese" nights, some women's luncheons and shopping. Oh, she also loved going to the Rec Center to exercise.

I last talked to "Miss Helen" on Monday, June 20th, when she came home from shopping but not the next two days. On June 22nd, I felt deep down that something was really wrong so my granddaughter, Ashley, and I went over to her house. We checked all the doors and windows, knocking on each multiple times and calling her name over and over, with no response.

I called the police after getting permission from her sister. The police came out, and after being convinced that she might be in there, the Fire Department was finally called. They gained access to her home and found her in her bedroom wedged between the bed and a side piece of furniture. She had been there for several days, with no air conditioning, in those horrible hot days that week. According to the EMTs, she was severely dehydrated, and it looked like she had suffered a stroke as well as a heart event, all to be determined if she even made it to the hospital. Before leaving, the EMTs told me that she would not have survived one more day if my "feeling" hadn't been right. The police, firemen, EMTs, neighbors and friends called me a "hero." I'm not a hero, just her friend who cares.

The last time I saw "Miss Helen" was my final visit to her in the hospital. She was paralyzed on her left side, unable to speak, and on palliative care, but she knew me by blinking "yes" and giving me a halfsmile while squeezing my hand. She kept squeezing until after I kissed her forehead when she fell asleep.

"Miss Helen" lived ten more days after being discovered the night of June 22nd. She's now free from the terror she must have felt, those hot days and nights, trapped in the home that she loved. The reason for my writing this is to ask all of the residents of our Pembroke communities to please be attentive to their neighbors, especially the elderly, disabled or those who live alone who perhaps are just in need of a friend who cares. You might just save a life, even for only a short while. I miss my friend!

# 28<sup>th</sup> Annual CLEAN THE BAY DAY

The 28th Annual Clean the Bay Day (CTBD) was another big success all around the Virginia Commonwealth. On Saturday, June 4, 2016 we saw sites all over Virginia teeming with volunteers on streams, rivers, trails, and shoreline giving a little back to our waterways. All those individual contributions have a massive cumulative effect: In just three short hours we saw hundreds of miles of stream and shoreline unburdened of harmful debris and litter by the ton... and several thousand people had a great time doing it.

All seven cities of Hampton Roads were absolutely overflowing with volunteers. The U.S. Navy had a precedent-setting turnout. Every state park in the watershed (22 total) participated. Richmond and Charlottesville saw a huge spike in participants this year. So, again, THANK YOU and your team for everything you have done to support the program this year. Here is a preliminary look at this year's numbers:

#### CTBD 2016 in summary:

Approximately 6,000 volunteers... Removed about 138,000 pounds of debris... From over 440 miles of stream and shoreline. (All in just three hours!). For more ways to help the bay please visit cbf.org/getinvolved






2. Log on to weatherunderground.com and check out station **KVAVIRGI192**. Our neighbors on Cambria Street broadcast current conditions world-wide.
