



BLIND CORNERS


I frequently get asked what can be done about dangerous "blind" intersections in our neighborhood. There are clear standards in article 2, section 201 of the VB City Zoning Ordinance.

Visibility at the intersection of driveways and streets can NOT be blocked by any hedge or structure **higher than 30 inches**. This applies to a triangle area 20 feet from any intersection or 10 feet from a driveway,

If you are concerned about an Intersection, first check if fences or shrubs in the "visibility triangle" violate the 30 inch rule. If they do, please bring it to the attention of the property owner - you will be doing them a favor, since VERY few people are aware of this rule. If the owner is unable to trim or remove the hazard, you might volunteer to help them. If the owner is unwilling to do anything, you could report it to the VB City Public Works department.

Property owners; please check your corners and help us prevent any tragic vehicle / pedestrian accidents in the neighborhood.
