

According to the records of the National Association of Realtors, there has been a dramatic change in the tenure of a family in a home. Prescription Medication Take Back Program

The Virginia Beach Police Department's Prescription Medication Take Back Program collected 2,533.5 pounds of voluntarily turned in medications at drop boxes in 2016. It is clear this program provides an outstanding service to the community because it provides a solution to preventing the misuse of prescription medications as well as the contamination of water supplies.

The VBPD also announced the recent addition of secure sharps containers to the collection boxes so citizens are now able to safely dispose of sharps. Prescription Medication Take Back Program collection boxes are located in the lobby of each precinct. This program is strictly designed for citizen drop off and not intended for pharmaceutical reps or doctor's offices. All unneeded prescriptions are turned in anonymously and no paperwork is required.

The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration reports 70% of youth who abuse prescription drugs admit to getting them from family or friends. Please take the time to help us keep these drugs off of our streets.
