

## **Our Neighborhood History**

(Part 1 of 3)

Since we are hosting our community pot-luck at **Old Donation Episcopal Church**, we thought you might like to know some history about it...

Old Donation Church is the third Lynnhaven Parish Church, and is the oldest Episcopal Church in Virginia Beach. Records show that the parish's first church services were held in 1637.

The current church is the 3<sup>rd</sup> building of the Lynnhaven Parish. The original site was located at Church Point. Due to rising waters of the Lynnhaven River the church was rapidly deteriorating. The grave sites became over washed by the rising tide with the major portion of grave stones under water. Some stones were retrieved and moved elsewhere.

A decision was made to build the church at a new location, thus in 1692 a new church was built with the specifics of "a good substantial brick church 45 feet in length, 22 feet in breadth and 13 feet in height". The current sanctuary was built in 1736 and was heavily damaged by fire in 1882.

The present church structure is a restoration using the original walls and was completed in 1916. The baptismal font was rescued from the waters of The Lynnhaven and stands as the sole survivor of the first Lynnhaven Parish Church. The grave yard holds the markers of many of the early members.

Old Donation was included on the National Register of Historic Places in 1972. You can find more information at **www.olddonation.org**.




