

Did You Know...

...There is a **GARDEN CLUB** in Pembroke Meadows, established approximately 50 years ago, Sept 11, 1969, and still going? And in need of new blood, new energy, new ideas, & your help...if it is to survive! Within Pembroke Meadows we help the Civic League Board by providing flowers for the Potluck Dinner, ordering and placing the median Christmas decorations and advising on plantings around the neighborhood and pool. We meet the second Thursday of the month, the day after the Council meeting.

Pembroke Meadows Garden Club (PMGC) is part of a larger organization called the Virginia Beach Council of Garden Clubs, which meets monthly at the local library. Programs are varied and may include power point presentations on various gardening topics, demonstrations of floral design, etc. There are many functions aside from the monthly meetings at many different venues which are open to club members. Each year the Council president chooses a project for the group. This year's project is to develop an educational garden at the Whitehurst/Buffington House on North Landing Road, an historical house which is being restored. 
