Our Real Estate Market:

What Impact Did the Tax Reform Have on the Luxury Market?

When the tax reform legislation (limiting the deduction of state and local property taxes as well as income or sales taxes, to a total of \$10,000) was put into law at the beginning of the year, many experts believed that it would have a negative impact on upper priced, luxury housing. Surprisingly, according to the National Association of Realtors, home sales between \$500,000-750,000 are up 11.9%, while sales between \$750,000-1 million are up 16.8% and those sales over 1 million are up 26.7%. Only time will tell for the long-term effect, but so far, so good!!!!
