


#### Presidents Corner:



#### **Home Price Predictions**

## SINGLE-USE ALKALINE BATTERIES (AA, AAA, C, D, 9V)

Because these batteries no longer contain mercury, you can dispose of them in your household trash!

## RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES (Li-lon, Ni-Cd, SSLA/Pb, Ni-MH, Ni-ZN)

Proper disposal is very important as these pose a fire hazard if not handled with care. NEVER put these in the trash.

Here are some helpful options:

1. AARP Tax Aides provide free tax preparation help on a first come, first-served basis at the Meyera E. Oberndorf Central Library. From now until Apr. 15<sup>th</sup>. Monday - Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m,

Saturday, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

AARP volunteers can assist with filing a tax return, if:

- Your income is low to moderate
- You have no rental income
- Your business has no inventory or employees
   Bring photo identification for the taxpayer, social security cards for all family members, last year's tax return, and any other supporting documents. You do not need to be a member of AARP or a retiree to use this service.

Walk-ins only. Space is limited - only 40 per day! First come, first served basis. Lines form early at the library
