

THE RISE OF MULTIGENERATIONAL HOUSEHOLDS

In recent years, multigenerational living has been on the rise. According to Virginia REALTORS Chief Economist, about 16% of Virginia residents lived in multigenerational households in 2001; in 2017, that share had risen to 22%. parents and children)
