

#### **Balloons**

Balloons are festive and fun — right? Not when they are released into the environment. The end result of releasing balloons into the environment is the ribbon wrapped around the wing of a bird or a shredded balloon that looks just like a jellyfish in the water being ingested by a sea turtle. Over 100 balloons have been found per mile in surveys on our Virginia coastal beaches. These balloon parts all end up in our waters where they endanger the wildlife that we love. There is an easy solution to this. We can all resolve to not releasing balloons and not use balloons outdoors where they can accidentally get loose.

There are alternatives — pennants and flags are an alternative that will create a festive environment. Planting a tree is a wonderful way to memorialize an important occasion. Share your ideas for balloon substitutes with us and thank you for avoiding balloons outdoors and protecting our wildlife.


