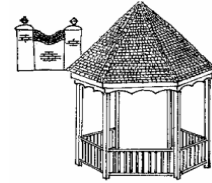



Presidents Corner

I want to thank everyone who voted in this first of its kind voting event. As we continue to struggle with not being able to have meetings, we will more than likely have more votes happen online. In other news around the hood, be on the lookout for work to finally begin on the median beautification project. After many hurdles and hoops to jump, our Garden Club has been able to reach a compromise with the City to buy plants from McDonalds Garden Center and have city workers install them. Also, make sure you read the article in this newsletter regarding our Halloween Walk for this year. We are trying extremely hard to not cancel the event for this year and we think our event chair-people have

come up with a great way to make it work. And when it comes to Halloween night, we are still waiting to hear from the city on any restrictions they are going to put in place. Once they announce anything, we will put it on the website and send it via email to ensure everyone hears about it.

Yard Debris Collection Rules

The following is for curbside collection:

- Limbs up to 4 feet long and 6 inches in diameter will be collected in a pile not to exceed 4 x 4 x 4 feet.
- Two piles, generated from each house, will be collected on each collection day.
- You may also dispose of smaller yard debris, such as grass and leaves (no dirt, rocks, mulch or root balls) in up to 25 clear plastic bags, not more than 25 lbs. per bag.
- Tree removal debris is not collected at the curbside. However, it can be collected through the yard debris container program, provided each piece is no larger than 6 inches in diameter.

31st Annual Halloween Walk

Saturday, October 24th at 3 p.m.

To accommodate Covid-19 best practices, we are planning a **modified** Halloween walk to safely maintain our neighborhood tradition. It will be a circular route, returning to the starting point. As always, since this is a "walk" please leave the skateboards, scooters, bikes, and dogs at home. Strollers, prams, carriages, wheelchairs, wagons, etc. are fine. This is for the safety and enjoyment for all.

We will begin at the medical complex on Whitechapel Drive, turn left to Cambria Street, right on Abbey Drive continuing to Severn Drive. We will then turn left back onto Abbey Drive and continue on to Cambria. At Cambria we will turn right and arrive back at Whitechapel.

Individual serving drinks and snacks will be offered at several stations at the medical complex to take with you marking the end of the walk. There will be no activities or food at the park.

If you choose not to walk, you are welcome to join us anywhere along the route and help cheer our little ghosts and goblins as they march to the music.

Neighbors handing out candy: Please just throw the candy out to the street as we did in the old days. We are discouraging kids from walking up to those distributing.

Parents: Please speak to your children about the importance of spacing and maintaining proper social distancing. **Instruct them to gather candy from the street and not to go up to those tossing candy.** It is for the safety of everyone. Please walk with your children and help whenever you see the need.

Be a volunteer---we need people to help with providing intersection security while the ghosts and goblins walk along the route and to help

with setting up and watching over the snack tables and coolers.

Box Turtles

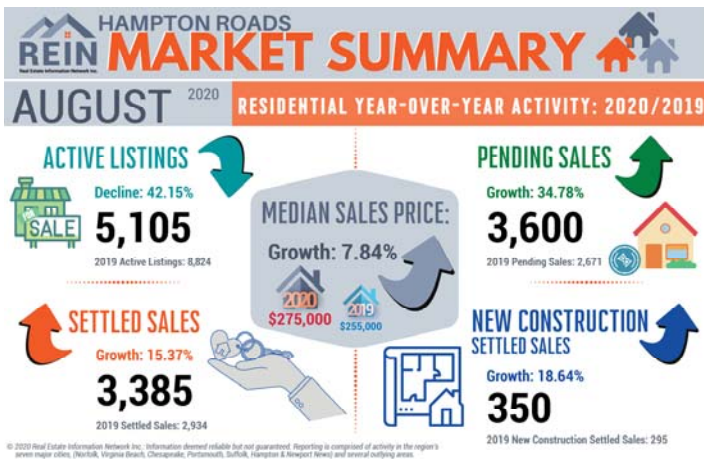

Download Virginia's free **COVIDWISE** Exposure Notifications app to help protect your community while protecting your privacy.

The Commonwealth of Virginia is the first state in the country to implement a **free** COVID-19 exposure notification app using the Apple/Google Bluetooth framework. The app is called COVIDWISE. This effort is an example of Virginia leading the way forward during the most pressing pandemic of our lifetimes.

The app was created with both public health and public trust in mind. It's easy to use. It ensures your privacy and it helps protect the health and safety of our communities. No location data or personally identifiable information is ever collected, stored or transmitted via this app.

I encourage all of us to download and use COVIDWISE. It is available from the App Store and Google Play Store. There is also a web page, covidwise.org, that provides lots of information about the app, including frequently asked questions and specifics about how the app works.
