

Neighborhood Business:


- Stopping at Stop Signs it has been brought to our attention that people are not coming to a complete stop at stop signs in the neighborhood. Per Virginia Law: Drivers must stop at the stop line, crosswalk, or intersection, whichever they encounter first. The driver must yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and approaching vehicles before proceeding. The driver should only proceed when it's safe to do so.



Severe Weather Preparedness

March 7-12, is Severe Weather Preparedness Week in VB.

Do you know how to prepare for a hurricane? Tornado? Flood? Here are tips for crazy Spring Tornadoes:

First, know the difference between a tornado watch and a tornado warning. A watch means be aware, conditions are ideal for possible tornado. A warning means a tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar and you should immediately seek shelter. Go to the lowest level of your home or building you're in, move to an inside room, a closet or hallway (no windows or doors), avoid corners, windows, doors and outer walls. If you are in a mobile home, leave immediately and head to the closest building or storm shelter. Finally, protect your head. 2022/2023 real estate assessments

The total assessed value of properties in Virginia Beach rose by more than 9 percent over the last year.

We're in the midst of a hot residential real estate market causing homes to sell quickly at or above asking prices which is the primary driver of the spike. The median home assessment across all residential properties jumped from \$267,600 in 2022 to \$297,900 for 2023.

Residential and Apartment properties appreciated significantly, but Commercial/industrial properties were flat. The median change in appreciation for residential properties was 11.05%, for apartments was 15.11% and for Commercial/Industrial properties was -0.01%.

New construction is down and has been for the last four quarters, but the cost of new residential construction has risen significantly, and changes are on the horizon for commercial properties.

The average assessment of a new home jumped from \$387,700 to \$545,900 in 2021. Only 737 new homes were built last year, that's down from 1,233 in 2020. This is likely due, in part, to cost increases, supply chain issues, increased demand and limited developable land. The homes being built are also in a higher value range with 22.3% below \$350,000 and 77.7% above.

On the commercial real estate side, this year, three new hotels are under construction and a new project at the Pembroke site could bring added commercial tax revenue.

For bills due June 5, 2022, the rate is still \$0.99 per \$100 of assessed value.
