33rd Annual Clean the Bay Day, June 4, 2022. DIY Week May 30-June 3, 2022

Each year, on the first Saturday of June, Virginia Beach residents descend on the rivers, streams, beaches as well as land-based properties of the Chesapeake Bay watershed to remove harmful litter and debris.

Since the origination of the event in 1989, approximately 152,000 Virginia volunteers have donated their time and energy towards the Clean the Bay Day event which has resulted in having removed more than 6.5 million pounds of debris from more than 7,390 miles of shoreline.

Established 30 years ago, Clean the Bay Day is a true Virginia Beach tradition and an annual opportunity for families, military installations, businesses, clubs, civic or church groups to give back to our environment.

This annual event also introduces participants to some of the greater, unseen problems the Bay watershed faces such as <u>degraded habitat</u>, <u>polluted runoff</u>, and <u>nitrogen and phosphorus pollution</u>.

We hope you will join us in our mission to save the Bay by learning more about the <u>Chesapeake Clean Water Blueprint</u> and work to restore and protect the Bay and it's rivers and streams.
