

Our Real Estate Market:

The Future of Home Price Appreciation

Many consumers are wondering what will happen with home values over the next few years. Some are concerned that the current run-up in home prices will lead to a situation similar to the housing crash 15 years ago. However, experts say the market is totally different today. For example, Odeta Kushi, Deputy Chief Economist at First American recently tweeted this

"...We do need price appreciation to slow today (it's not sustainable over the long run) but high price growth today is supported by fundamentals - short supply, lower rates and demographic demand. And we are in a much different and safer space: better credit quality, low DTI (Debt To Income), and tons of equity. Hence, a crash in prices is very unlikely."

Price appreciation will slow from the double digit levels the market has seen over the last two years. However, experts believe home values will not depreciate (where a home would lose value).



A New Voting System in Virginia Beach


I know many of you have been following the changes in the Virginia Beach City Council districts and the system by which we elect our City Council representatives in Virginia Beach. Our old districts have been redrawn and we now have 10 wards. Each ward contains approximately 45,000 residents.


The other very significant change is that we will be voting for the representative from our own district alone. No longer will residents be voting on all city council members. The only remaining at- large position will be the mayor.

There is more information about these changes and a map of the new wards on the city's website. You can enter your address to find your new ward and its demographic profile. Our neighborhood appears to be split between Districts 8 and 9.
