Lost Pet Program

New Coordinator Needed!

Gerry Richter has handled this program for over 20 years. She is **RETIRING. A new family or families is urgently needed to take over.**

Gerry keeps a listing of pets that have been registered via Lost Pet Program Forms which she will gladly turn over to a new coordinator.

The Civic League has helped sponsor this program and in the past 20 years at least 800 to 1,000 pets have been reunited with their owners.

The tasks involved include the following:

1. Collect and maintain the lost pet forms and continue to encourage owners to put identification on their pet to make contact easier. Forms are most often mailed to the Treasurer who then forwards them to the coordinator.

2. Be willing to help re-unite a lost or found pet with the owner.

3. Hold on to a pet (in garage or yard) until the owner can be notified or found.

4. If needed, take a picture and post it on NEXT DOOR --we get a good response from this site.

5. If the owner is not found, contact Animal Control who will scan the pet for a CHIP.

6. For the animal's own safety, do not let it loose, turn it over to Animal Control.

Most effective would be to have two households who can get involved and work on this together. If you would like to step up, please contact Gerry at 757-497-5243. It would be a shame to see this program go away.
