

Know your City Code

Sec 5-532. - Barking dogs.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep a dog without exercising proper care and control of such dog to prevent it from disturbing the peace of others by barking, whining, howling, or crying without provocation in a loud, continuous or untimely manner. Any person, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee or otherwise, in charge or control of the property where such dog is kept, or the owner of such dog, shall be responsible for exercising control of such dog under this section.

Dog owners, please be considerate of your neighbors. Neighbors; if you can't work things out you may file a complaint with VB Animal Control.



Vanishing Oatmeal Raisin Cookies

- 1/2 pound (2 sticks) margarine or butter, softened
- 1 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
 - 2 eggs
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1-1/2 cups all-purpose flour
 - 1 teaspoon baking soda
 - 1 teaspoon cinnamon
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt (optional)
 - 3 cups Quaker® Oats (Quick or Old Fashioned, uncooked)
 - 1 cup raisins

- 1. Heat oven to 350° F.
- 2. Beat together margarine and sugars until creamy.
- 3. Add eggs and vanilla; beat well.
- 4. Add combined flour, baking soda, cinnamon and salt: mix well.
- 5. Stir in oats and raisins; mix well.
- Drop by rounded tablespoonfuls onto ungreased cookie sheet.
- 7. Bake 10 to 12 minutes or until golden brown.
- 8. Cool 1 minute on cookie sheet; remove to wire rack.

About 4 dozen



3ar Cookies: Bake 30 to 35 minutes in ungreased 13 x 9-inch metal baking pan.
