


## **Take Me Out To The Ball Game!**

## PET LOST AND FOUND PROGRAM

**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY** - pets found with no identification or collar will be turned over to Animal Control.

We are getting an influx of "DUMPED dogs...mainly at the park, school grounds and in our neighborhood. Those of us that are part of our wonderful lost and found program have no way of knowing the overall temperament of these animals, nor do we know whether or not they have had their shots - most important the rabies shot. Thus, for both the dogs safety and ours, the safest option is to contact Animal Control. They will provide a safe environment, food and care until an owner has been identified or the animal, once evaluated, can be put up for adoption. Be sure to put identification on your pet.


### How is the Local Real Estate Market?
