

Branches & Yard Debris

Yard Debris

- Acceptable examples of bagged yard debris: grass clippings, leaves, pine straw, shrub trimmings
- Bag yard debris in clear bags only
- Limit 25 bags per home/per collection day
- Bags cannot exceed 25 lbs. per bag
- Place bags & branches on the curb in front of your <u>own home</u> no earlier than 5:00 pm the night before your regular collection day.

Branches

- Group loose branches into bundles. Tied bundles are preferred but not required.
- Limit one (1) bundle per home/per collection day.
- Limbs up to 4 feet long and 6 inches in diameter will be collected.
- Bundles/Piles cannot exceed 4 x 4 x 4 feet.
- Bundles/Piles should be no smaller than 3 x 3 x 3 feet

Waste Management is actively recruiting CDL Drivers.

CDL Hiring Bonus: Newly hired candidates with a valid Commercial Driver's License qualify for positions as Waste Management Operator II and will receive a \$2,000 sign-on bonus.

Not accepted in the Yard Waste Service:

- =Any work that was done by a contractor (tree and yard debris)
- =Roots balls, mulch, dirt, rocks will not be collected.
- =Animal feces (bagged or unbagged)
- =No dead animals (or live ones)
- =Small piles of twigs/branches (bag and place in trash cart)
- =Loose leaves/grass/vines

Please Note:

- It is the responsibility of the resident to clean up any small debris left after collection. Residents can bag this debris and place it in their trash
- cart
- Any work done by private contractors (tree company, landscaper, lawn company) must be disposed of by the contractor.

Yard Debris Container Program



- For larger amounts of yard debris, roll-off containers are available on a first come, first-serve basis. There is a fee for this service: \$40 for weekdays and \$75 for weekends.
- The container is only to be used for tree limbs less than 6 inches in diameter, leaves, shrubbery, and grass trimmings from the normal upkeep of the immediate perimeter of your occupied dwelling.
- You may schedule the container for a day with AM or PM delivery available. However, trailers delivered on Friday will be picked up on Monday.
- Someone at least 18 years old must sign for the trailer when delivered but need not be home when it is picked up.

Please call 757-385-4650 well in advance if you wish to schedule a container. This service is not available online.

OUR REAL ESTATE MARKET

How is the Local Real Estate Market?

According to data compiled by REIN, the leading provider of real estate data in Hampton Roads, there has been a significant increase in the median sales price (MSP) of homes sold. With nearly a 5% increase from April to May, a record high of \$335,000 MSP for the region was reached.

Inventory remains tight as we head into the summer. Many consumers who might otherwise choose to sell their homes appear unwilling to do so, as both home prices and mortgage rates are higher than they have been in recent years, according to Jon McAchran, President of REIN's Board of Directors.

"The local real estate market remains relatively strong, "McAchran said. "Prices have been steady over the past few months, whereas a number of markets across the nation have seen their selling prices weaken."

What's lacking, he said, is enough inventory to meet the needs of potential buyers.

"Even with mortgage rates up and the price of homes higher, people are buying."

Voting Time!

It's your chance to serve the pool community on the Pembroke Meadows Recreation Center Board! The Board is always looking for new perspectives and talents to add to the group, so please consider adding your name to the ballot.:)

Assistant Director (2 year position): The Assistant Director shall perform such reasonable duties as may be requested by the Director, and be responsible for hiring and management of Recreation Center employees.

Treasurer (2 year position): The Treasurer shall perform such duties pertaining to his/her office as may be reasonably requested by the Director, and attend to and be responsible for: keeping the accounts of the Recreation Center, collecting the revenues and for paying the bills as approved by the Recreation Committee. The Treasurer will also deposit funds of the Center received by him/her, in the name of the Center, in such deposits as may be authorized by the Recreation Committee; render written monthly reports to the Director; be present for annual audit of the Recreation Committee books and records and ensure that the annual financial report is submitted to the Civic League of Pembroke Meadows, Incorporated Board of Directors prior to the 30th day of December of each year; be the chairman of the finance sub-committee; and ensure that all financial liabilities (wages, insurance, taxes, utilities, etc.) are met in a timely manner, making all disbursements by check drawn on the Center account.

Five **At-Large** (1 year): At-Large Board members are expected to participate in monthly meetings, assist with decision making, vote and lead a self-chosen committee that may include one of the following: Events, Communication, Facilities, Volunteers and/or By-laws.
