



Builders React to Homebuying Affordability

Buying a home can feel tough right now, but there is some good news: builders are focusing their efforts on smaller homes and some are even offering buyer incentives.

During the pandemic, homebuyers were looking for larger homes with bigger spaces to allow working from home, setting up home gyms and extra rooms for virtual school and builders responded. Now, with affordability tight, builders have turned their focus to smaller singlefamily homes. The average new home in 2020 had approximately 2260 square feet compared with todays new build of approximately 2070 square feet.

A 1968 view of the man made lake at the entrance to Pembroke Meadows and Pembroke Shores with the Original Gazebo. (Note Independence Blvd. in the background.)

There was a fountain, water wheel, bridge and water fall in the lake. The lake was stocked with ducks. A large play and picnic area was within the fencing. This was all located between Independence Blvd. and Whitechapel Drive where the medical center is now located. A view or the bridge and original model homes and 2nd gazebo. Scott Dashiell is feeding the ducks at the lake in 1968.

There were originally 2 gazebos; one at the Pembroke Blvd. entrance where our current gazebo is located and another at the entrance to the man made lake & park. The lake was later drained and filled with dirt. This is where the medical center is now.
