



How Much Will Mortgage Rates Drop This Year?

A few months ago, experts were forecasting mortgage rates could dip below 6% by the end of the year. Recent projections suggest that may not happen. While mortgage rates are still expected to decline some later this year, projections from Fannie Mae, Mortgage Bankers Association and Wells Fargo now show them stabilizing closer to the 6.5% to 7% range. By law, the City must assess all properties annually by the end of January. Real Estate taxes make up approx. 30% of Virginia Beach's annual General Fund Revenue. This pays for public education, fire, police, roads, public education and much more.

The City's current tax rate is \$0.97 per \$100 of assessed value.
